Seventy years on, the mystery of Amelia endures

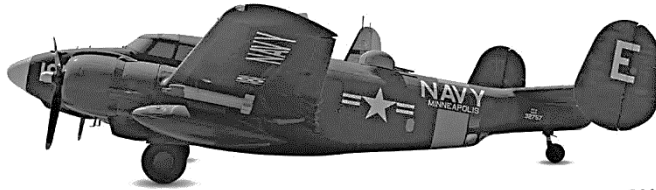
Amelia Earhart, one of the first female aviators, has been missing since 1937. She was attempting a round-the-world flight when, on July 2 1937, her plane disappeared over the Pacific Ocean. Despite a huge search effort, no body or wreckage was ever found.

Opinions are divided as to what happened to Amelia. Jack Berger, an aviation expert, firmly believes that the plane ran out of fuel and crashed into the ocean, where Amelia drowned. Berger's reasonable theory is poles apart from other, more outlandish,

explanations. For example, another popular belief is that Amelia ditched her plane on purpose, and went to spy on the Japanese. Even more unlikely is that she completed the round-the-world trip, but didn't want to be in the spotlight anymore, so moved

to a small town in the US and changed her name.

It seems extremely unlikely that we will ever know for sure what happened to Amelia. What is not a matter of opinion however, is that Amelia was declared dead in 1939, despite no body ever being found.
